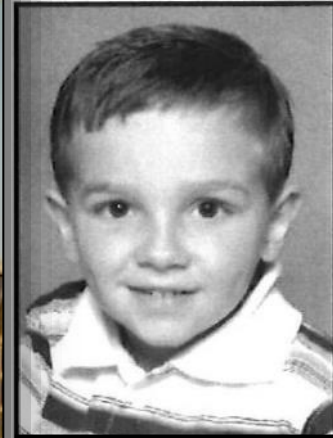
Levittown Guitar and Choir Ensemble Perform for Little Village

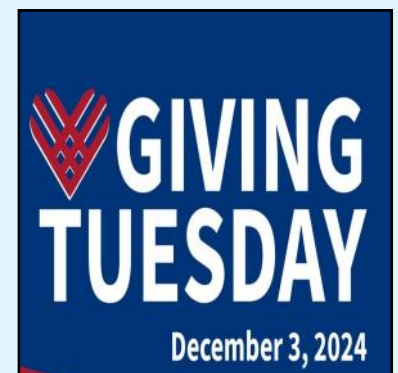
